## **SUMAVA NATIONAL PARK**

We the undersigned organizations are writing this open letter to express our great concern about proposals by the Environment Ministry of the Czech Republic to declassify substantial areas within the core of the Sumava National Park from their present strictly protected status which precludes intervention management activity.

We understand this will enable widespread logging, motivated by bark beetle infestation, as well as reducing the proportion of the Park allocated to the non intervention area and facilitating the prospect of building development in adjacent localities.

Widely known as the "Wild Heart of Europe" this area is iconic among scientists, and in the tourism sector, for the intact state of its ecology governed by natural processes, and for the unspoiled beauty of its landscape. It is seen as a symbol of the care which the Czech Republic extends towards its natural heritage.

Yet there is widespread concern that the actions currently planned will cause damage to this ecology that will take many decades to repair, as well as changing the character of the wider area forever. The opportunity to allow natural development after bark beetle attack would be lost, despite this having been demonstrated as viable, both in the Bavarian Forest and central parts of Sumava itself. Furthermore, years of spontaneous forest regeneration, so valuable in ecological terms, would be destroyed.

Above all, there is a clear signal that even the best known National Parks are not protected.

Benefits cited in support of these actions do not appear to be underwritten by scientific opinion, and the actions themselves we understand are widely opposed by conservation institutions in the Czech Republic and elsewhere.

We very much hope you will earn a justified reputation as guardian of the unique heritage of Sumava for future generations in the Czech Republic, and more widely, by withdrawing forthcoming plans and legislation.

In particular we believe it is important to ensure that:

- the size of the core wilderness zones of the Park are not further reduced against the 26% agreed in 2011
- no logging occurs in core areas, and the zone boundaries are not otherwise altered to enable felling in current core areas
- 3) the current status of the Park, which by international standards equates to IUCN Category II, remains unchanged and its level of protection is thus not downgraded
- 4) the current plan for expansion of the core zone to at least 50% of the Park area by 2030 is not discontinued
- any new legislation does not permit new developments, including ski lifts and hotels, within the Park

This action would truly exemplify the Czech Republic's reputation as a model of progressive, science-based conservation, and provide international reassurance of the enduring quality of protection conferred by National Park status.
